THE STORY OF CHRISTMAS

4 In a field nearby, shepherds were taking care of their sheep. All of a sudden, the night sky lit up and filled with angels singing, announcing the birth of the Messiah. At first, the shepherds were shocked but quickly realized something very good had happened. They ran to see where Jesus had been born. When they saw the baby and realized that God's plan to help His people was finally happening- they were so excited! The great help of the world that they had been waiting for was finally here! Jesus was born.



2 On one very ordinary day, God did something special. He sent an angel to talk to a young woman named Mary. The angel told Mary that she was pregnant with God's son and He would bring help to all people. At first, Mary was confused by the news. But God used angels to calm her fears and remind her that this was good news for everyone!

Advent Acts of Service

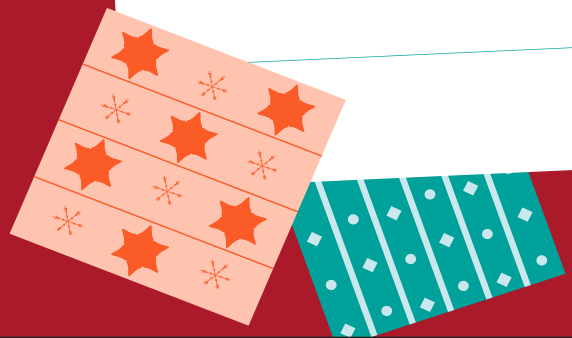
Here is a list of suggestions for acts of service.

- Pray before you open gifts, and give thanks to God for His gift of Jesus



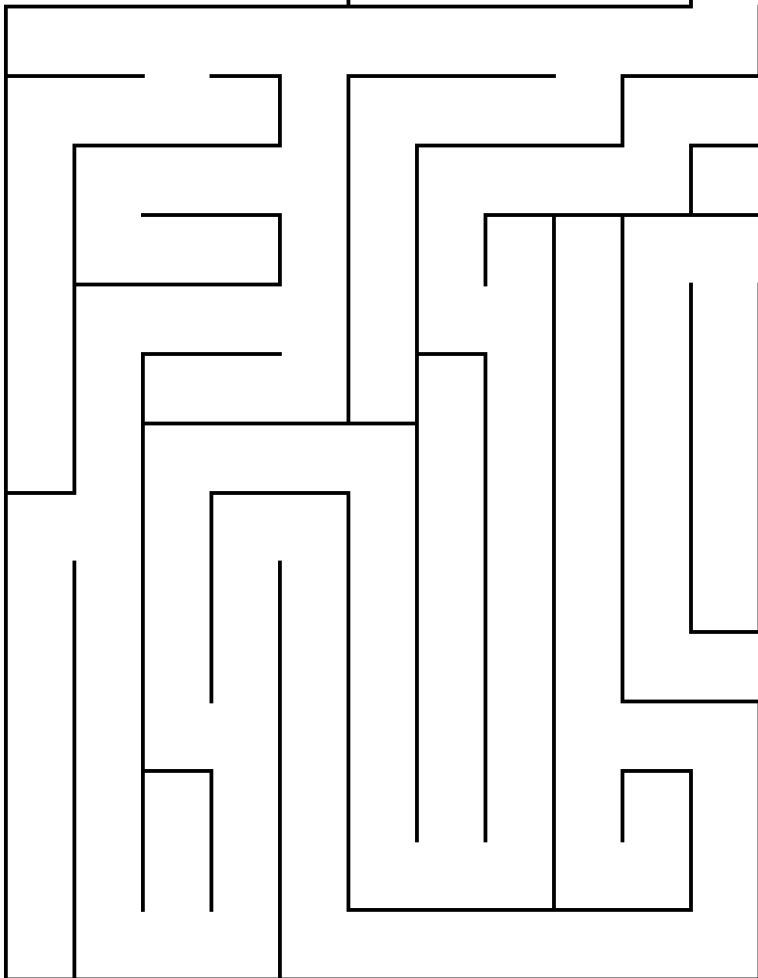
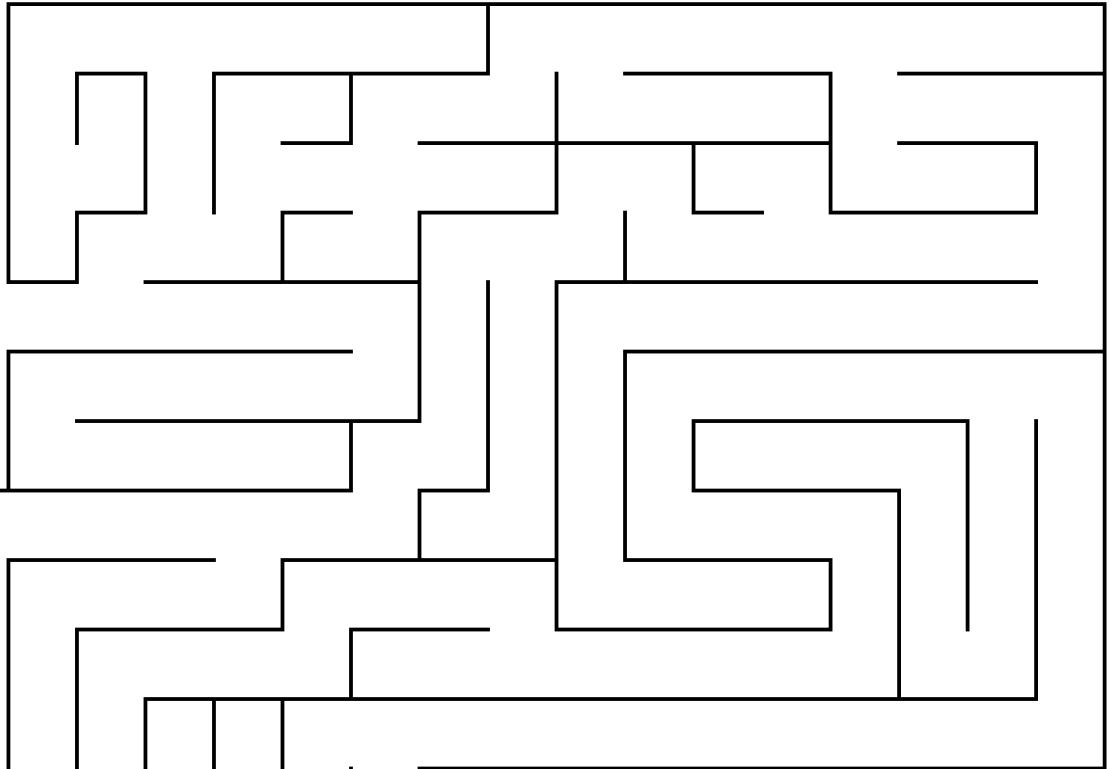
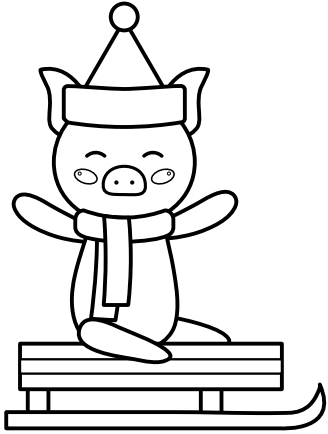

Christmas Recipes

Christmas bagels

dark chocolate 2/3 cup

powdered sugar 2/3 cup

grind in crumb

egg yolk x 2

flour 2 cups

butter 1 stick

crumble pistachio 2/3 cup

knead the dough, put into the refrigerator for one hour

mix

bake in preheated oven 10-15 min.

1 pinch Salt

Bake for 12-15 min in a preheated oven 350°F
